The EnableNSW SEED Program provides essential equipment for discharge to eligible people with a newly sustained spinal injury or acquired brain injury. For further information please see the program [factsheet](#) online or contact us using the details below.

The following is provided as a quick guide to applying for the SEED Program and equipment.



Step 1

To apply for the SEED Program the *Clinical Service* sends:

- a completed [Consumer Application Form](#) attached to an email with the subject line clearly marked as '**SEED APPLICATION** for *name & date of birth*' written into the subject line, and including
- the [additional clinical information](#) required.



Step 2

EnableNSW will advise the outcome of the SEED application by letter to the person and email to the clinical service.



Step 3

The *Clinical Service* prescriber sends in the:

- [Stock Equipment Request Form \(SERF\)](#) marked as SEED, for items in the Equipment Allocation Program, or
- [Equipment Request Form/s \(ERF\)](#) marked as SEED.



Step 4

EnableNSW will advise the outcome of the equipment request by letter to the person and email to the clinician.
